# 'Bathurst Remembers World War 2 Exhibition 2021'

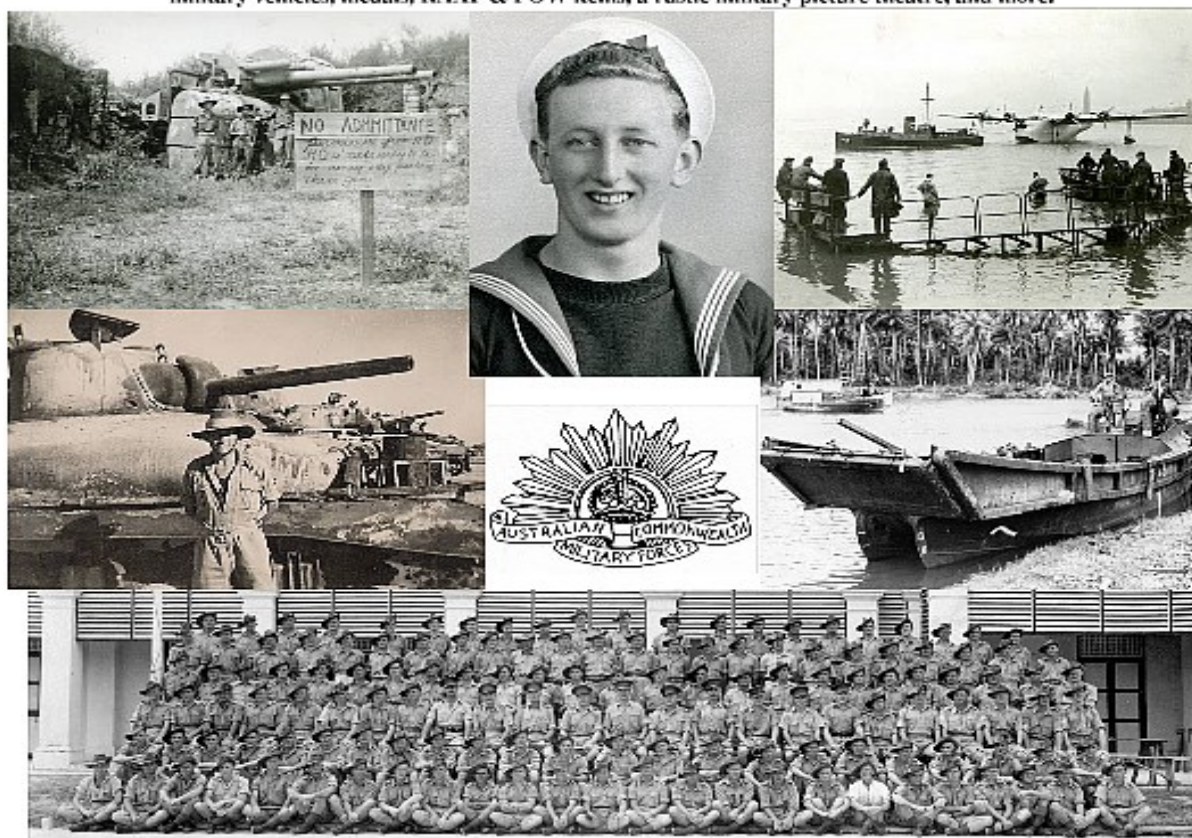
**Marking VJ Day and 75th Anniversary of the end of WW2**

Exhibition from Friday 13th August to Monday 16th August 2021 - Open: 9am to 5pm

The four day event will be held in four pavilions at the Bathurst Showground, Sydney Road

This WW2 Exhibition will consist of "Snapshots of World War 2" - 600 enlarged photos of soldiers in action, battlefields, training, the home front, Bathurst Army Camp, etc. There will also be the "Wall of Valour" - Over 130 enlarged photos of World War 2 Service Men and Women with an association with Bathurst who enlisted and served."

Guest Exhibitors will display over 3,000 military items and WW2 memorabilia, uniforms, a WW2 model railway, military vehicles, medals, RAAF & POW items, a rustic military picture theatre, and more.
